Division	Coord	Comments
<b>Tee Ball</b> TeeBall@	Steven Rosen	<b>Ages 4 &amp; 5</b> - The focus of the tee ball division is to introduce the player to the sport while offering opportunities to develop their skills. All players will bat from a tee. Runners will advance one base at a time. Games are 1 hour and 30 minutes in length. There is no scoring or standings. All players will receive a special tee ball recognition award at the conclusion of the season. <b>All new 5-year-old players to EYLL will play tee ball.</b>
<b>Pioneer</b> Pioneer@	Ron Garcia	<b>Ages 5, 6 &amp; 7</b> - This division will focus on instructing younger players in baseball fundamentals. The coaches will pitch using a soft-safety baseball. <b>Second year EYLL 5-year-old players are allowed by Little League regulations to participate in this division.</b> The tee ball or pioneer decision will be made by the parent. There will be no standings kept in Pioneer. All players will receive a instructional recognition award at the conclusion of the season.
<b>Rookie</b> Rookie@	Dan Mendoza	<b>Ages 7, 8 &amp; 9</b> - This is an instructional level of Little League minors that will focus on teaching younger players baseball fundamentals. Coaches will be on the field during games to provide instruction. Games in the division are split between <b>coach</b> and <b>player pitch</b> . A tournament may be held at the end of the season where the players on the first and second place teams will receive a place recognition award.
<b>Minors</b> Minors@	Jason Luis	<b>Ages 8, 9, 10 &amp; 11</b> - This is developmental level with limited stealing. Pitchers will only be allowed to pitch 3 innings and a set number of pitches per game. The number of pitches is determined by Little League Baseball. A 12-year-old player will NOT be allowed to pitch in this level. The 1st and 2nd place teams will receive a place recognition award.
<b>Majors</b> Majors@	Edwin Heredia	<b>Ages 10, 11 &amp; 12</b> - The players will be competing on a 46/60 field. The division managers will rate and draft new players into the division. 9-year-old players are allowed to try out for Majors. The duty of the league officers is to organize a competitive division; therefore, parents are asked to refrain from making requests that may affect the objective. <b>Teams will be redrafted in 2023.</b> The 1st and 2nd place teams will receive place recognition awards.
<b>Junior Baseball</b> JuniorBB@	Richard Ramos	<b>Ages 13 to 16</b> - EYLL will be running an in-house league at Warinanco park. At this level, the players will be on a full size (60/90) baseball field.
